

Fast Facts -CSW 68

Health, Poverty and Gender*

In 2019, an American women's life expectancy decreased to 81.4 years, 3.2 years lower than the average across other nations, and four years lower than women in Italy, Switzerland, France, Spain, and Japan.

In 2021, only 68% of US women felt they received high-quality general healthcare and only 72% of US women felt they received good pregnancy care from health facilities. Between 2019 and 2021, there was a dramatic 60% increase in maternal mortality in the US, a rate not seen since 1965 and the highest in the developed world, with Black women dying at a rate 2.6 times more than white or Hispanic women.
