## Women's Employment and Poverty\*

Women's global labor force participation is under 47%, 25% lower than men's and most of the women are in disproportionately low-wage service positions.

Women experience heightened risks of poverty. Even in rich countries like the US, out of 38.1 M living in poverty in the 56% were women, the majority women of color.

During the past two decades women in the US have earned between 80-82% as much as men with Black and Hispanic women earning 64% and 57% as much respectively.
